Feel free to bring any snacks or a lunch with you – they will provide donuts and coffee in the am and a \*VERY\* light snack between the shows.


**You MUST be willing to get to school BY 5AM** (Bus Stop at Campanile & Hardy by the KPBS Building) because the bus will be leaving then for LA.
