What are the qualifications?

The qualifications for membership set by the national organization include the following:

- Registration for major or minor that is psychological in nature (ex. CSP, CFD, social work); pre-majors are not qualified for Psi Chi
 - Minimum of 12 units in psychology at SDSU with a 3.5 Psychology GPA (consists of major preparatory classes *and* major requirement classes)
 - At least one semester completed at SDSU, transfer/graduate students are not qualified to apply during their first semester at SDSU
 - Minimum overall GPA of 3.5
 - Completed at least 3 semesters in college/university (including at other institutions if applicable)
 - \$85 application fee in cash or check. Application fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**, please make sure you meet the qualifications before applying

Application Procedures:

1. Send to our email, psych.sdsu@gmail.com, a pdf of your complete downloaded **Degree Audit Report (DARS)** for proof of your GPA, psychology classes, and unit requirements. If you do not have a DARS, then a transcript from each institution you have attended is required. *Transcripts do NOT need to be official.* Be advised that there is often a fee and delay for requesting official transcripts and junior colleges may often require a personal or written request.
2. After getting a “You are eligible” email response from our officers.
3. Complete the attached applications and registration cards from this packet. You must print legibly or have it typed out. If we cannot read your applicant and registration card, you may not be accepted. Make sure to sign the card before turning in the application.
4. You also **MUST** fill out the application at <http://www.psichi.org>. First, click join, then become a member. If you do not do this step in addition to turning in the physical copy of your application to our Psi Chi chapter, you will not be a recognized international member. Then send the confirmation email or filled out application to our email at psych.sdsu@gmail.com
5. Submit a payment of \$85.00 (\$60 is the national fee and \$25 is the SDSU chapter fee) through Venmo.
6. **Requirements:** undergraduate students must complete at least 3 semesters of college coursework, nine units of psychology at SDSU, have registered for the major or minor in psychology for a related subject (ex. CSP, CFD, Social Work), and have a minimum overall *and* psychology GPA of 3.5. If you are uncertain about whether you meet these requirements, contact psych.sdsu@gmail.com or just complete the eligibility check.
7. All fees will be paid to SDSU’s Psi Chi chapter via Venmo (@angieexga).
